

The ELN-Website was built up with a so called Content-Management-System (CMS). A CMS is a computer software system for organising and facilitating collaborative creation of documents and other content in the web. With a CMS, the act of "writing content" is separated from the act of "compiling it" into any particular form.

The CMS-Training addresses to the web-editors of the ELN as well as to all other interested network members of the European LeukemiaNet and Kompetenznetz "Akute und chronische Leukämien".

You will learn, how to add content to the website, how to present images, files and other information.

There is no previous IT-knowledge required and everybody is invited to participate. Private laptops for the practical part are highly welcome, wireless LAN is provided. The number of participants is limited to 15 persons, to make sure that the training is most effective.
